The public comment period will end on April 16, 2010. The Consolidated Plan ("The Plan") is a strategic plan that provides a course of action for building livable communities throughout the County. The Plan describes the County's goals and objectives to address priority needs related to affordable housing, homelessness, non-homeless special needs populations and community development, which includes economic development, revitalization, community infrastructure, and public services.

The Plan is developed through a collaborative process, in which a community establishes a unified vision for housing and community development actions. It offers local jurisdictions the opportunity to plan strategically with citizen participation in a comprehensive context and reduce duplication of effort at the local level. The Plan is also a prerequisite in order to receive federal funds.
