

**NOTICE OF COMMUNITY FORUM

PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND**

Prince George's County Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) is developing the Consolidated Plan for Housing and Community Development covering fiscal years 2011 through 2015, and hereby solicits public comment from residents of the County. The Consolidated Plan is a collaborative process through which a community establishes a unified vision for community development actions. It offers local jurisdictions the opportunity to plan strategically with citizen participation in a comprehensive context, and to reduce duplication of effort at the local level. The Consolidated Plan is also the means to meet the federal funding requirements for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG), and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) programs; Community Development Block Grant-Recovery (CDBG-R) program, Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) program, and the Homelessness Prevention & Rapid Re-housing Recovery Program (HPRP).

To solicit comments from the residents of Prince George's County and to obtain citizens' views on the priority needs for housing, special populations, general public services, community infrastructure, economic development and revitalization a Community Forum will be held:
