Sprint/Nextel 9020 Baltimore Avenue College Park
This application lists frequencies presently authorized by the FCC for LightSquared's use to be operated from Sprint's antennas. Sprint has entered into an agreement to host LightSquared's network on its system and to use frequencies assigned to LightSquared. The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has issued a Public Notice prohibiting LightSquared from commencing operations on its assigned frequencies until the FCC, in consultation with the National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA), finds that Global Positioning System (GPS) interference concerns have been satisfactorily resolved. Consequently, we condition our recommendation on approval from the FCC for use and activation of service for those frequencies and assignment of those frequencies by LightSquared to Sprint.

Service providers must submit general location plans of facilities that are anticipated to be built in the future, to the County no later than July 31st of each year. The general location of the future facilities must be identified on a copy of the Councilmanic District Map. These yearly submissions must be sent directly to TTFCC Chairperson, Cheryl Collins, cfcollins@co.pg.md.us, at 9400 Peppercorn Place, Suite 600, Largo, Maryland 20774.

Service Providers not in compliance by the specified deadline will have future TTFCC requests placed on hold until required information is provided and accepted by the Chairperson. There are no exceptions.
