Sheriff Accepts Board Position

Prince Georges County Sheriff Michael A. Jackson has been tapped to serve on the University of Maryland University College (UMUC) Criminal Justice Advisory Board. His 20 years of law enforcement experience will be called upon as he offers advice and guidance to the Criminal Justice curriculum that UMUC offers its students.

Sheriff Jackson, who himself earned a Masters of Science in Management from the John Hopkins University in May, said "law enforcement is forever evolving; we'll chart the newest trends important to crime prevention and implement them into the UMUC program."
