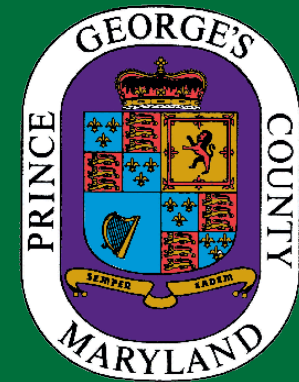

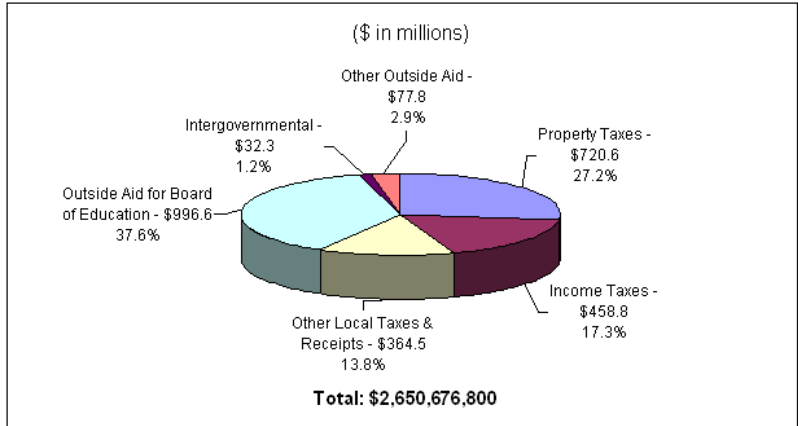

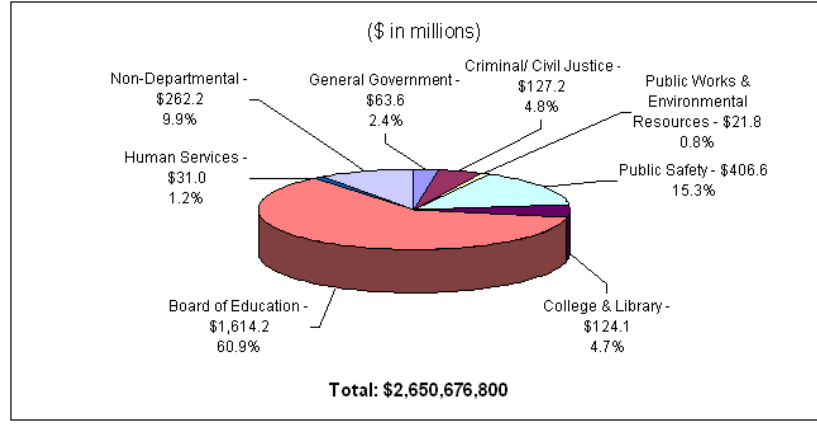


County Budget: FY2012 Revenues and Expenditures

FY 2012: Highlights

July 1, 2011 – June 30, 2012



- \$18 Million increase to the Board of Education
 - County Council restored \$7.5 million to address specialty program bus service, Reading Recovery, Headstart/PreK, and Camp Schmidt
- Public Safety: 150 new police recruits (total 1,610 officers); 60 new Fire/EMS recruits and \$4.2 million for Fire Department apparatus
- Added six additional code enforcement officers and restored funding to the Health Department to compensate for reductions in state and federal funding
- \$50 million Economic Development Incentive Fund
- Budget is essentially at FY2008 levels-No County tax increases

Redevelopment • Revitalization • Smart Growth

- Passage of land use plans throughout Council District 3
- Held Economic Development Tour, June 2010, to encourage developers to look at investing in Prince George's County
- Brought County Executive's Economic Team to District 3 to highlight the economic potential of the University of Maryland, including adding amenities near M-square Research Park, ensuring start-up companies stay in the County, and East Campus project moving forward.

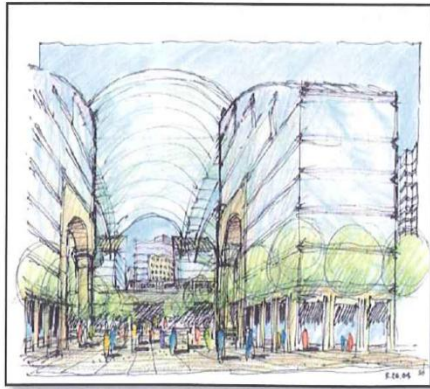

Conceptual rendering of the New Carrollton Metrorail station

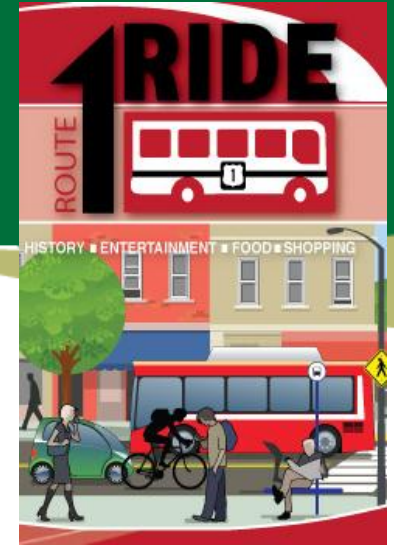
