MACo Board of Directors Taps Turner to Serve as Treasurer

Prince George's County Council Member Ingrid Turner (D) – District 4, has been selected by the Maryland Association of Counties (MACo) Board of Directors to serve as Treasurer for Legislative Year 2011. Council Member Turner was elected to the leadership post during the recent MACo Summer Conference in Ocean City, Maryland.

"Council Member Turner has proven herself to be a good partner during her years of service on the MACo Board of Directors," said MACo President and Harford County, Maryland Executive David Craig. "I look forward to extending that partnership as we work together as Association officers. She will be an excellent leader for MACo."

MACo is a non-profit organization advocating county issues at the state government level. Members of MACo are the elected officials of Maryland's 23 counties and Baltimore City. Members determine association positions on executive and legislative proposals through a Legislative Committee comprising membership from each jurisdiction, and govern the association through a Board of Directors, elected by the membership.
