COUNCIL CHAIR INGRID M. TURNER CONTINUES “READ 4 SUCCESS” PROGRAM

Turner visits Kenilworth and Tulip Grove Elementary Schools

Prince George's County Council Chair Ingrid M. Turner (D) – District 4, continued her *Read 4 Success* program on Friday, January 21, 2011 at Kenilworth Elementary School, 9:00 a.m. and Tulip Grove Elementary School at 10:30 am. This program serves to continue her efforts in stressing the importance of reading to young children. Council Chair Turner will make several visits to District 4 elementary schools within the next few months.

During her visit to both elementary schools, Council Chair Turner read from the books, *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*, by Roald Dahl to the third grade classes and *Frindle* by Andrew Clements to the fourth grade classes. As part of this program, she provided each student with a copy of the book.

Council Chair Turner wants to cultivate the love to read within the students by encouraging them to read aloud. “I always enjoy visiting the schools and reading aloud to the students. I also encourage them to read aloud because it encourages the children to listen, to ask questions and to see that reading is fun.”

Council Chair Turner will continue her *Read 4 Success* program throughout the remainder of the school year.
