COUNCIL MEMBER INGRID M. TURNER SPONSORS ESSAY CONTEST FOR NATIONALS TICKETS

Contest open to 3rd through 8th graders in District 4

Prince George's County Council Member Ingrid M. Turner (D) – District 4 is sponsoring an essay contest open to third through eighth graders to qualify to win tickets to a Nationals clinic and game. The contest has begun and essays are due no later than July 19, 2010. Five contestants will be selected to win tickets to the clinic and game scheduled on August 14, 2010. All participants will receive a certificate of participation and the first 50 essay submissions will receive a Nationals baseball hat.

The essay entitled "Why is baseball your favorite past-time?" must include a registration form with the contestants name, address, telephone number, name of group or school and name of parent or guardian. The essays must be submitted by July 19, 2010 and there is no cost to enter. The contest winners will be notified by letter and must be accompanied to the clinic and game by a friend, parent or guardian.
